Official Workplan**

In this Workplan, you can find all the information you need to take part in the Pole Sport CSIT World Sports Games Cup 2021. Please read this document carefully and send POSA the filled in form at the end of the Workplan.

The Municipality of Cervia will be the host of the VII. CSIT WORLD SPORTS GAMES (WSG 2021), together with the technical partner AiCS - Associazione Italiana Cultura Sport and in partnership with the municipalities of Cesena, Cesenatico, Ravenna, and Emilia Romagna Region. The WSG will be held in the adjacent cities of Cervia (main host), Cesena, Cesenatico, and Ravenna from October 12-17, 2021.

The Municipality of Cervia and AiCS - Associazione Italiana Cultura Sport are welcoming CSIT, its World Sports Games, the International Workers & Amateur Sports Movement, its partners (like POSA) and the several thousands of amateur athletes as well as participants from all over the world to practice and compete in sports and sports for all activities in the best atmosphere and conditions. The CSIT World Sports Games offer a unique opportunity to meet in an amicable way and get to know an international sports community in a festival-like setting.

In 2021 we have a new challenge to face: the health protection of athletes and participants linked to Coronavirus pandemic. The Municipality of Cervia and AiCS have set up a concept aiming to respond to the updated international and national legal framework. Moreover, for the WSG2021 the organizational committee (EMILIOC) has engaged, among other specialists, a "COVID Manager" who is coordinating a task force to secure participants for all the phases: before the arrival, during the event and after the games. Participants should also know that a safety event is possible as much as behaviour of participants move accordingly with the anti COVID measures adopted.

Pole Sport World Cup:

The Pole Sport competition will take place over three days 14-15-16 October:

Day 1, 14 of October: set-up and stage rehearsals

Day 2, 15 of October: Pole Sport competition for amateur categories

Day 3, 16 of October: Pole Sport competition for competitive categories

Rehearsals stage

The stage rehearsals will be **without music**, each athlete will have 1.30 minutes to rehearse the stage, each delegation will be sent the rehearsals programme divided by each national delegation.

POSA

Competition running order:

Starting order of the finals, is made according to the draw of lots, this will be made in Olympic Training Centre of Tirrenia (Italy), on the 5th of September 2021, by the official representatives of the POSA.

The top ten from all categories will qualify for the POSA Pole Sport World Championship 2021, on 11-12 December.

In case of a tie at any position at the end of the qualification, see POSA Code of Points.

The order of all categories for competitions in the finals as follows:

- Juniors, Seniors, Masters, Para Pole.

Access to the Competition Area

- The competition area is accessible to members of the various juries, competing athletes and their accredited coaches, to local group leaders, to the auxiliary personnel of the Jury, to the Head of the POSA Antidoping Commission, the official competition doctor, the team doctors, medical staff and to persons concerned with the apparatus.
- Interpreters September not enter the competition area without the permission of the President of the POSA/TC.
- The competition area is strictly forbidden to all other persons.
- The use of any kind of electronic devices (video, mobile phones, etc.) is strictly forbidden in the competition area. Please note that, according to the decision of the Executive Committee of POSA, if a mobile phone or any other electronic communication device is used in the competition area during the entire competition, the person concerned (athlete and/or coach) will be immediately expelled. The athlete will not be ranked and will not be authorized to participate in the remaining competitions. If this rule is violated by a coach, all his/her athletes will also be expelled.

Award Ceremonies

The ceremonies in the competition venue will take place as follows:

- For all Amateur categories on the 15th of October
- For all Competitive categories on the 16th of October

List of Difficulty Elements

At the accreditation, the Heads of Delegation must give the list of difficulty elements (Difficulty Sheet), for each competitor(s) by each category (Seniors and Juniors). Athletes, however, must send their "Difficulty Sheet" to the Athlete Chair by the deadline of 6th of October. email: contact@posaworld.org

Competition Attire Publicity

Any advertisement displayed on any leotard worn by a competitor must be approved by the Head Judges (according to the POSA rules of publicity). Everything is specifying in POSA Rules & Regulations.

Music

To limit the technical problems with the music used for the competitions, the Organizing Committee has decided to only accept the athlete's music in an **MP3 format only** (CD, USB sticks etc. are accepted). All music used during the Pole Sport CSIT World Sports Games Cup, must be submitted online, via email until October 5th, 2021. Music can be submitted electronically via a drop box link or as an attachment to contact@posaworld.org

Each music file will have to contain the following information:

- The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country).
- The first and last name of the competitor/s.
- The category.
- The length of the music.
- The Junior or Senior (Example: ROU_RADU_Alina_Junior_IW2_3min30s_mp3)

Doping Control

Any doping is prohibited. A doping control test can be requested at any time, in accordance with the POSA regulations. Doping controls will be carried out in accordance with the WADA-NADO regulations. Judges' instruction and draw of lots.

All judges must participate in the briefing sessions as described in the Competition Schedule. Short judges' briefings will take place before each competition.

- According to the POSA Rules, the presence of the judges to the judges' instruction is mandatory. The judges' instruction will be held in English.
- The judges' oath will be carried out at the end of the judges' instruction, by one of the host federation judges.

Inquiries Procedure

Inquiries for the difficulty scores will be allowed, if they will be made verbally, immediately after the publication of the score or at the very latest before the end of the routine of the following athlete. For the last athlete of a rotation (rotation=group of athletes, for example 1st Group of athletes during the competition, this is called "rotation"), this limit is one minute after the score is shown on the scoreboard. The person designated to receive the verbal inquiry will have to note the time of receiving it and this will start the procedure. Only the accredited coaches present in the competition area will be entitled to submit an inquiry. Late verbal inquiries will be rejected.

A federation (or delegation of the same country) will not be allowed to complain against an athlete from another federation or delegation. The inquiry will have to be confirmed as soon as possible in writing, but within 4 minutes at the latest after the verbal inquiry and will require an agreement of payment of EUR 150—for the first complaint, EUR 300 — for the second complaint and EUR 600— for the third complaint. Should the inquiry not be confirmed in writing within 4 minutes, then the procedure will become obsolete.

Should the inquiry prove correct and be accepted, this sum will be reimbursed. Every inquiry will be examined by the Superior Jury and a final decision, which September not be appealed, will be taken at the very latest:

- At the end of the rotation for the qualifying competitions, or at the end of all-around competitions.
- Before the score of the following athlete is shown for the finals.

The detailed procedure is laid out in the respective POSA Code of Points.

Tie Breaking Rule

- In case of a tie at any position at the end of the qualification see POSA Code of Points
- In case of a tie at any position at the end of finals see POSA Code of Points

The Organization of the Event

Delegations admitted.

The following athletes are eligible to participate in the World Cup:

- 1- The top 5 classified of the 2019 Pole Sport World Championships
- 2- The first 3 classified (Amateurs and Competitive) of the 2020 National Championships.
- 3- All those automatically admitted by the international federation (Wild Card Athletes).

For any delegation it is possible to bring one more athlete per individual category, as reserve. This athlete must pay the application fee as any other athlete.

POSA

Warning: In case of a change of category for age reasons (e.g., from JA to JB, or from JB to Senior), those athletes who are forced (according to the rules) to change to the different category can compete in the different category, even if the number of athletes in that category is already fulfilled.

For this reason, some categories September have more athletes than allowed.

The Technical Committee is evaluating new rules for these situations, which will only be applied after the CSIT-World Sports Games 2021.

Doubles: In case of injury or renunciation of one of the two qualified Doubles members, it is possible for them to replace the resigning athlete with a different athlete (all this must be communicated via email to contact@posaworld.org). POSA wants to give the opportunity to the Doubles athlete who has remained without a partner (but who is qualified by law), to compete in any case. If this is not possible, athletes must communicate as soon as possible, their renunciation to compete, to give way to Doubles number 4 in their national ranking, to be able to compete at the CSIT- World Sports Games 2021.

If no announcement is received by athletes or the National Federation within the established deadline, the National Team will no longer have the right to enter any other Doubles in the competition, replacing the renouncing Doubles. Deadline for all these communications: September 15th , 2021.

Everything is specified in POSA Rules & Regulations.

Accreditation & Registration

Accreditation and registration permit the identification of all participants and indicates the access to certain zones. Access to all zones will be controlled. Badges must be visibly worn throughout the whole event. During the accreditation, the Heads of Delegation will verify the identity of the members of their delegation as well as all requirements regarding accommodation, meals, and registrations. They must make the necessary payments, hand over the back-up thumb drives for their athletes, the thumb drive with the national anthem and their national flag. The LOC suggests to all Federation to bring thumb drives only.

Registration will be carried out upon arrival. The registration check in booth will be on lobby of the Sport Hall. This area is right in front of the main competition hall. Each athlete will also receive the official CSIT badge, as well as the POSA badge, which will be distributed directly at the Sport Hall on 14th of October. The accreditation/registration is personal, non-transferable, and necessary for access to the training and competition halls. POSA Directives and Technical Regulations will be strictly applied, especially about the number of persons accredited per nation.

Accreditations are provided to each delegation having fulfilled their financial obligations.

In every package chosen, the fee for participation in the pole sport competition is already included.

Both athletes and coaches must choose a package.

POSA

To register for the Pole Sport CSIT World Sports Games Cup the athletes and/or National Federation must complete the followings tasks:

- Submission of their music (MP3 format) to the LOC
- National Anthem submitted to the Athlete Chair. Clearly mark the National Anthem with the name of the country. (Example: National Anthem – France)
- Proof of payment to confirm that the athletes attending have paid the registration fee via link in POSA site or bank transfer.
- Difficulty Sheets for each athlete have been submitted to the Athlete Chair.
- Copy of Passport for each athlete (JPEG format)
- Picture of each member of the delegation, Coach or medical staff member attending within your registration (JPEG format)

Registration will not be accepted past August 20th, 2021.

Upon accreditation and acceptance of your national federation's registration, the Head of Delegation is responsible for providing to the organizing committee the following:

- The medical insurance for the members of the delegation if not already provided.
- Bring music on a thumb drive. The thumb drives will be returned to the Heads of Delegation after the athlete last competition. It is recommended that spare thumb drive be brought for safety reasons.
- National Flag for the opening ceremonies.
- A copy of the Medical Certificate/Diploma for medical personnel. POSA will collect and record these certificates. Please note that without this document, the accreditation of the medical personnel will NOT be released.
- Documented proof of a negative Covid 19 swab (dated one week or less) or a self-certification that you have had no contact whatsoever with people infected with Covid 19 in the 15 days preceding the competition.
- For the accreditation process, only the Head of Delegation (or his representative) or the coach is requested to present himself/herself at the Registration Center.

Opening Ceremony

The Official POSA competition Opening Ceremony will be held on October 15th for all athletes, in the Competition Hall at 09h00. The ceremony will consist of Flags Presentation by nation with the competitors by nation performing a special greeting for the audience. All competitors must wear their national tracksuit. **We remind you that the Official Opening Ceremony of the CSIT World Sports Games 2021 (with all delegations from all sports), will be on the 12nd of October.**

Medical Services

The LOC will provide the necessary medical services.

Insurance

POSA Technical Regulations stipulate that all participating federations or athletes, must assume all costs in relation to the medical insurance of all delegation members (illness and accidents). The Local Organising Committee has the right to verify the validity of the insurance upon arrival of the delegations (policy insurance, original or copy). You will find all the information about insurance in this Workplan on page 13.

Entering the Pole Sport CSIT World Sports Games Cup without valid medical insurance of all delegation members will be rejected.

Visa

Please check whether you need a visa to enter Italy. The Local Organising Committee will assist you applying for a visa with pleasure.

Warning: Due to the international situation caused by the Covid 19 pandemic, athletes are advised to book their flights no earlier than July 2021 to ensure they can complete their trip. It is also advisable to obtain adequate information from the Italian embassy in your country regarding the necessary conditions required for the trip.

All athletes and coaches must present at the time of registration (14 October) a Covid 19 vaccination certificate (double dose of vaccine or single dose in case of Johnson&Johnson vaccine), or a certificate of recovery from Covid 19, or a certificate of negativity to the Covid 19 rapid swab carried out no more than **48** days prior to registration.

The Pole Sport CSIT World Sports Games Cup for Juniors, Seniors, Masters and Para Pole, in Cervia (Italy), 2021, will take place under the following regulations.

- The current Codes of Points and the followings remarks, or documents issued by the POSA/PS TC.

- WADA Internationals Regulations.
- The POSA Antidoping Rules
- The current POSA General Judges' Rules (Code of Ethics).

PACKAGES

The package prices of the two categories include: competition fee, full board accommodation, local public transport in Cesenatico and Cervia, registration fees, welcome package and free chiropractic services by FICS per person.

Please note: All POSA-athletes are to be registered under the standard Category POSA, except the athletes, who are simultaneously members of the Israeli federation HAPOEL and those from the Italian federation AICS, because both federations are members of CSIT.

- **CATEGORY L (for all POSA athletes): for all POSA athletes who do not use the full-board accommodation packages above and are from the region of Emilia-Romagna pay:**
Athletes: **130 euros registration fee**
Coaches & Accompanying persons: **95 euros registration fee**

Deadline for submitting DEFINITIVE REGISTRATION :

Payment: until August 20th , 2021 Please note: packages C and L do not include any hotel accommodation. For this reason, athletes applying with package C and/or L will have to provide their own accommodation.

Cancellation policy

- In order to be officially registered all registration payments have to be transferred from POSA to the organizer (CSIT) until the definitive registration deadline on **September 1st, 2021**.
- In case of cancellation by a registered participant **until August 30th, 2021**, POSA will refund all payments (100%).
- Cancellation **between September 2nd and September 8th, 2021**, the organizer (CSIT) will refund 50% of the total sum.
- Last minute cancellation **between September 8th and September 14th, 2021**, the organizer (CSIT) will refund 25% of the total sum.
- **After September 14th 2021** no refund will be conducted.

Take note that: a special total Insurance policy Covid-19 related is issues for WSG2021

From September 25th to October 12nd, 2021 each WSG2021 participant will be able to cancel the participation at the Games, by showing EMILIOC the positive result of the Covid-19 test. The participant will be fully reimbursed of all WSG package expenses. The insurance policy is optional. The insurance is added on the registration platform and can be chosen with an additional cost of the 3% of the total amount of the WSG package fee. The registration process on the official website provides the declaration.


